Digest: In order by code, summarize the main additions, revisions, or removal of direction incorporated in this supplement.

41.23 - Provides direction for review of existing structures or improvements on recreation residence lots, determination of whether to authorize, modify or remove existing structures or improvements, and use of conditional acceptance and compliance required.

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41.23 - Fire pits and fire rings: There shall be no more than one fire ring OR fire pit on each lot. Fire rings/fire pits should be no more than 4 feet inside diameter and not greater than 18 inches in height. All rings/pits that exceed these parameters must be removed or reduced. Rock and mortared fire pits/rings that meet the above size requirements will be allowed to remain. Fire rings that have incorporated large boulders which are part of the forest landscape, will be allowed to remain, but the constructed portion must not exceed the parameters above. Reconstructed fire rings/pits will not be mortared.

41.23 - Driveways: Driveways shall be limited to one driveway, single lane in width with parking for two vehicles. Any additional vehicles must park within the designated driveway or in the tract's authorized designated parking area. Existing pull-through driveways shall be evaluated for resource impacts. If impacts exist, the pull-through driveway will be removed and the area restored to its natural state, or impacts will be otherwise mitigated. If there are no resource impacts, the pull-through driveway may remain. All other unauthorized driveways and parking areas will be eliminated and the area restored to its natural state.
