

## CHAPTER FOUR

# LIST OF PREPARERS

Revision of the *Forest Plan* for the Arapaho and Roosevelt National Forests and Pawnee National Grassland has been a major effort. A small group of five called the "Core Team" has remained almost intact since the revision effort began in 1991. The Interdisciplinary Team has seen some turnover. The following members are those who have been or are currently still assigned to the teams and had a direct responsibility for preparation of the document:

HOWARD ALDEN, Recreation Planner. BS Biology; MS Forest Ecology; PhD Forest Recreation. Howard was responsible for the recreation resource analysis and monitoring and evaluation portions of the *Forest Plan* revision.

TOM ANDREWS, Research Natural Area Ecologist. MS Plant Ecology, PhD Organic Chemistry. Tom assisted in preparation of the *FEIS* and *Forest Plan* sections dealing with Research Natural Areas.

LYNNE BRIDGFORD, GIS Specialist. BS Outdoor Recreation, MS Forest Management/GIS. Lynne is responsible for development of the Forest's databases and the GIS analysis.

KRISTI BUFFINGTON, GIS Technician. BS Forest Management, MS Remote Sensing/GIS. Kristi helped develop the Forest's databases and GIS analysis.

VERONICA BUSTAMANTE-MITCHELL, Civil Engineer. BS Civil Engineering. Veronica was responsible for the Travel Management and Facilities portions of the *FEIS* and the *Forest Plan*.

He is presently pursuing a graduate degree in fire ecology and effects. He provided input on fire ecology to the planning process and prepared the Fire Section of Chapter Three.

PAULA GUENTHER-GLOSS, Fisheries Biologist. BS Zoology/Fisheries, MS Water Resource Management. Paula has experience in fisheries and water quality research as well as natural resource planning and environmental coordination. She helped prepare the Aquatics and Riparian Section of this *FEIS*.

GORDON HAIN, Recreation and Wilderness Management. BS Forestry. Gordon helped prepare the Recreation Section of this *FEIS* and helped complete forestwide and management area standards and guidelines for the *Forest Plan*.

LAURA HUDNELL, Soil Scientist. BS Geography/Soils, currently working towards MS Ecology/Soils. Laura serves as the Forest Soil Scientist and Air Resource Coordinator. She prepared the Soil and Air Sections of this *FEIS*.

DEBRA L. JENSEN, Interdisciplinary Planner. BS Forestry. Debra has 15 years experience with the Forest Service in timber, recreation and planning. She is an ID Team member and was responsible for the social and economic analysis and the wild and scenic rivers analysis. She prepared these sections of the *FEIS*.

STEPHEN E. JOHNSON, Forester. MS. Steve has 17 years timber management experience, including silviculture, inventory, and sale preparation. Steve assisted in all areas for preparation of the Timber Production section of the *FEIS*.

DAVID W. JOHNSON, Plant Pathologist. BS Forestry, MS Forest Management/Forest Pathology, PhD Forest Pathology. David worked 25 years in Regions 6 and 2 as Forest Pathologist.
