### **CEDAR SPRINGS MARINA UNDER REPAIR**

After the fueling accident, which caused a fire that destroyed the store and café at Cedar Springs Marina last week, crews are busy securing docks and restoring electricity to the Marina. Temporary lighting has been installed, and access is available for renters to get to their boats stored in slips. There is currently no fuel service except to “Slip Rental” customers.

The Cedar Springs boat ramp and all other boat ramps are accessible, except Anvil Draw boat ramp.

Because of the unsafe conditions, while repairs and construction is happening at the Cedar Springs Marina, the Forest Service asks that the public not access the marina area. There is absolutely no fuel transfer allowed on the boat ramp or near the marina area.

Currently the reservoir is experiencing fluctuating water levels that can cause hazardous boating conditions. Please use extra caution during this time of fluctuating water levels.
