### Anaconda-Pintler Wilderness

Welcome to your National Wilderness Preservation System.  
Enjoy this Wilderness, but please abide by all regulations to protect and preserve the Wilderness.

#### REGISTRATION & GROUPS

- All wilderness users must register. Registration forms are available at trailheads.
- Groups may not exceed 12 people and 12 head of stock.

#### STOCK

- Use proper stock containment methods.
- Grazing and tethering of stock within 200 feet of any lake is prohibited.
- Camping with stock is prohibited within 1/4 mile of:  
Sawed Cabin, Creamnos, and Ripple Lakes.
- Hope Lake Trail #424 is closed to stock
- Weed Seed Free Feed is required for stock.
- Stock is prohibited within 200 feet of Big Johnson Lake except on designated trails.
- Use of stock on the Pintler District is prohibited from April 1 through July 1.

#### FIRE

- Campfires are NOT allowed within 1/4 mile of the following lakes: Creamnos, Sawed Cabin, Upper Phyllis, Upper Carpp, Surprise, Bear, Buck, Emerald, Lost Lakes, Lower Phyllis, Park Lakes, Sauer, Continental, the unnamed lake below Queener Mtn., the unnamed lake west of Warren Lake.
- Where fires are permitted, use only dead and down wood. Please use a fire pan, fire blanket, or mound fire.

#### SANITATION

- Pack out all trash.
- Wash 200 feet away from lakes and streams.
- Bury human waste at least 200 feet from water sources.
- Properly dispose of toilet paper. We prefer that you carry it out.

#### CAMPING

- Camping is prohibited between Trails #96 and #111 and Johnson Lake.
- Maximum length of campsite occupancy is 16 days on the Beaverhead-DeerlodgeNF and 14 days on the Bitterroot National Forest.

#### OTHER CONCERNS

- Remember, as in all wilderness, bicycles, motor vehicles, carts and aircraft are not allowed, nor is motorized equipment such as chainsaws.
- Do not disturb natural features.
- Do not cut switchbacks. Stay on established trails.
- Respect the quiet that wilderness offers.
