Administrative Correction # 1

Administrative corrections are defined at 36 CFR 219.7(b) (2008 Planning Rule) and may be made at any time and are not plan amendments or revisions, and do not require public notice or the preparation of an environmental document under Forest Service NEPA procedures.

Administrative corrections include the following:

1. Corrections and updates of data and maps;
2. Corrections of typographical errors or other non-substantive changes;
3. Changes in the monitoring program and monitoring information (§ 219.6(b));
4. Changes in timber management projections or other projections of uses or activities; and
5. Other changes in the plan document or set of documents that are not substantive changes in the plan components

A. Typographical Errors

The following typographical errors were found after the Forest Plan was printed in 2006. They have been shown on our Forest web site as “Errata” since May, 2006.

2006 Forest Plan	TOC-4	Incorrect name for Appendix H; Currently reads: “Appendix H – Vegetation Management for Oak Ecosystem Maintenance, should read: Appendix H – Lease-specific Oil and Gas Notifications/Stipulations ”
2006 Forest Plan	2-25	Under Goal 6.1, the end of the goal statement currently reads “(See Wildlife Habitat Objectives 8.1a through 8.1f.)” This references the wrong objectives. The reference should read: “(See Wildlife Habitat Objectives 4.1a through 4.1g.)”
2006 Forest Plan	2-73	Numbering of Objectives under Goal 17.3 inadvertently changed. This is a typographical error. Objectives following Objective 17.3b currently show as being numbered 17.4c, 17.4d, 17.4e, 17.4f, and 17.4g; they should be numbered 17.3c, 17.3d, 17.3e, 17.3f, and 17.3g.
2006 Forest Plan	3-35	In the long-term desired habitat composition listing, bullet # 5 should have been indented to line up with the other indented bullets under bullet # 4.

B. Non-substantive Change - Definitions

Following printing of the 2006 Forest Plan we found that one of our updates to the definitions in Forest Plan Appendix A was inadvertently left out. This is a typographical error that is a non-substantive change to the monitoring questions.

2006 Forest Plan	A-11	Definition of Intermediate treatments was inadvertently left out of Appendix A. It should read as follows: intermediate treatments - An inclusive term for any treatment designed to enhance growth, quality, vigor, and composition of the stand between establishment of the stand and the regeneration cut(s). (See intermediate cutting. Types of intermediate treatments include thinning, release, and improvement cuttings.)

Corrected Page A-11 is attached.

C. Monitoring Information

Following printing of the 2006 Forest Plan we found that one of our updates to the monitoring questions in Chapter 4 was inadvertently left out. We have shown this on our Forest web site as an "Errata" since May, 2006. This is a typographical error that is a non-substantive change to the monitoring questions.

2006 Forest Plan	4-13	In Section 4.2 Section 10.1a the monitoring question currently reads "Are minerals standards, guidelines and stipulations providing environmentally sound exploration and development of Federal and private minerals and energy resources" it should read as follows " Are expressions of interest and lease offers processed in a timely manner? "
