Reward Money to be Paid only in 2005

Bounties to be paid in 2005, while grant funds remain, for this onetime opportunity:

- \$50** for new location at least 1 mile from a mapped location of the same species
- \$75** for a new location of that species in a new major watershed
- \$100** for a location of a species new to the mountain range
- \$200** for a location of a species new to the county or ranger district

Guiding Principles

Reference authority for the 18 statewide qualifying noxious weeds is *Noxious Weed Field Guide for Utah*, 2nd Edition, 2004. In many cases, roads adjacent to the Forest will bound the reward areas. However, locations of field bindweed, hoary cress, perennial pepper weed, and quackgrass must be within the Forest boundaries. Because of locally abundant areas, the combined bounties paid for these four species may be limited to \$1,000 per district. Also, rewards for the following three species will be validated only for locations **on** the Forest (within the county listed): buffalobur (Millard), bull thistle (Beaver), and Russian-olive (Sevier and Wayne).

Recipients cannot be permanent, full-time federal employees. Seasonal and part-time employees may be limited to a \$200 total. Those who might qualify to exceed this \$200 total will be pre-approved case by case.
