5-Year Program of Work Summary
LOLO NATIONAL FOREST
Superior Ranger District

No Changes Proposed: During this 5 year time frame, there are no changes proposed for the Randolph Creek Warming Shelter.

Proposed Changes in Season of Operation: A decrease in season of operation is being proposed for Diamond Lake, Missoula Lake, and Moore Lake Campgrounds, as well as at Maynard Loge and Heart Lake Trailheads. These sites will remain open and fully maintained during their active season of use and will receive a reduced level of service during the remainder of the year.

Proposed New Fees: No new fees are proposed at developed sites on the Superior Ranger District.

Proposed Increase in Existing Fees: Within the 5 year time frame, the District does propose to increase fees at Cabin City Campground, Savenac Cookhouse and Bunkhouse Cabin Rentals, and the West Cottage and Up Up Lookout Cabin Rental. Fees are put directly back into the sites for maintenance and improvements. Any new fees or fee increases will need to undergo further public involvement as per the regulations in the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act (FLREA or REA).

Proposed Increase or Improvement in Services: The District proposes to improve the services at Cabin City, Slowey, Quartz, and Trout Creek Campgrounds, as well as at Thompson Peak Lookout and Savenac Cookhouse and Bunkhouse Cabin Rentals.

Proposed Removal of Services: Trash services are being proposed for elimination in Cabin City Campground.

Proposed Removal of Facilities: There are no developed recreation sites being proposed for removal on the Superior Ranger District at this time.
