Reservations and first come first serve.

Sites are available on a first come-first serve basis in campgrounds within the reservation system. Campgrounds are reserved through www.recreation.gov or call (877) 444-6777.

Antelope Lake Recreation Area / Elev. 5000'

Antelope Lake is one of the more remote, quiet lakes on the forest. Located 30 miles NE of Taylorsville on the Genesee-Antelope Lake Road, or from Janesville, take County Rd. 208 for 4 miles, FS road 28N01 for 9 miles, turn right on FS road 28N03 for 2 miles. **Supplies** including groceries, ice, bait, and souvenirs are available from Memorial Day-Labor Day.

Boulder Creek Campground

- 35 units, tent/trailer
- Reservations/First come- first serve
- \$23 single site fee/ \$25 lakeside
- water, vault toilets,

Lone Rock Campground

- 87 units, tent/trailer
- Reservations/First come-first serve
- \$25 single site fee,
- water, vault toilets
- car-top boat launch

Long Point Campground

- 38 units, tent/trailer
- Reservations/First come-first serve
- \$25 single site,
- water, vault toilets

Long Point Group Campground

- 4 units, tent/trailer
- Reservations only
- \$75 site fee (25 people per site)
- water, vault toilets

Bucks Lake Recreation Area/

Elev. 5000' - 5400'

Located 32 miles northeast of Oroville on Oroville-Bucks Lake Road, or 17 miles west of Quincy on Oroville-Bucks Lake Road. Bucks Lake is a high mountain lake surrounded by the Bucks Lake Wilderness on one side and recreation residences/resorts on the other side. Showers available at Sandy Point Day Use/Boat Launch.

Supplies and **boat rentals** are available at resorts.

Whitehorse Campground

- 20 units tent/trailer, first come-first serve
- \$23 single site fee
- 3 Equestrian sites (no corrals)
- water, vault toilets, bear boxes

Sundew Campground

- 22 units tent/trailer, first come-first serve
- \$25 single site
- water, vault toilets, bear boxes

Mill Creek Campground

- 10 units, tent/trailer, - first come-first serve
- \$25 single site, \$25 lakeside
- water, vault toilet, bear boxes

Lower Bucks Campground / Day Use Area

- 7 units for tent/trailers with self-contained sewage storage
- first come-first serve
- \$20 campsite fee
- no water; vault toilet, bear boxes

Grizzly Creek Campground

- 11 units - first come-first serve
- \$20 site fee
- Vault toilet, tent/trailer

Hutchins Group Campground

- 3 units, tent/trailer,
- Reservations only
- \$75 site fee (25 people per site)
- water, vault toilets, bear boxes

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Feather River Canyon Area / Elev. 2300'-2600'

Located 32 miles west of Quincy on Hwy 70, Gansner Bar, North Fork, and Queen Lily are located on the west branch of the north fork of the Feather River along Caribou Road. Hallsted is located along the Feather River on Hwy 70 just 17 miles west of Quincy. Supplies are available in Belden, Twain, and Quincy.

Gansner Bar Campground

- 17 units - first come-first serve
- \$25 single site fee, tent/trailer
- water, flush toilets, bear boxes

North Fork Campground

- 21 units - first come-first serve
- \$25 single site fee; \$32 w/electric (4 sites)
- water, showers, flush toilets, bear boxes

Queen Lily Campground

- 12 units - first come-first serve
- \$25 single site fee, tent/trailer,
- water, flush toilets, bear boxes

Hallsted Campground

Located 17 miles west of Quincy on Hwy 70, near Twain.

- 20 units
- Reservations
- \$25 single site fee tent/trailer, \$32 with electrical hookups
- water, flush toilets, bear boxes, showers

Spanish Creek Campground / Elev. 3,200'

Off Hwy. 70, 8 miles west of Quincy. Supplies available in Quincy. 21 units Reservations/First come-first serve

- 21 units, tent/trailer
- \$25 single site fee
- Water, vault toilets

Spanish Creek Group Campground

- 3 units - reservable
- \$75 per night/
- 25 people per site
- water, vault toilets, bear boxes

Greenville Campground / Elev. 3,500

Located 1 mi. north of Greenville on Hwy 89, 9 miles SE of Lake Almanor

- 17 units - first come-first serve
- \$20 single site fee
- water, vault toilets, tents/trailers

Non Fee Campgrounds

The following **5** campgrounds are **"Self Service," no fees** are charged. All have **Vault Toilets**. There is **no piped water**. Trailer space is available with the exception of Silver Lake Campground.

Deanes Valley Campground / Elev. 4,400' 4 miles SW of Quincy. Off Bucks Lake Rd, take the Slate Creek/Deanes Valley Rd.

- 7 units - first come-first serve

Silver Lake Campground / Elev. 5,800' Off Bucks Lake Rd, 16 miles west of Quincy.

- 9 units - first come-first serve

Snake Lake Campground / Elev. 5,800'

Off Bucks Lake Rd., eight miles northwest of Quincy.

- 17 units - first come-first serve
- 8 Equestrian sites with corrals

Brady's Camp Campground / Elev. 7,200' Off Hwy. 70, 6 miles east of Quincy. Take Squirrel Creek turnoff, go 8 miles toward Argentine Lookout.

- 6 units - first come-first serve

Meadow Camp

Located approximately 10 miles west of Quincy, off o Forest Service Rd. 24N29. Streamside campsites. Both RV and tent camping.

- 6 units - first come-first serve
- 3 equestrian sites
- no water, no restrooms



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
