One mile south of Hollis, AR on Arkansas Scenic 7 Byway.


IRON SPRINGS: Wooded roadside setting on stream near historic springs.

Day use area, picnicking, three shelters, vault toilet, accessible walkway to springs, hiking in area.

On Arkansas Scenic 7 Byway, 4.5 miles north of Jessieville, AR.




FOURCHE MOUNTAIN: Scenic view from mountain-top.


LAKE SYLVIA: Beautiful 16-acre lake nestled in the mountains.

Camping (27 units plus group facilities), swimming, picnicking, accessible flush toilet, drinking water, dump-station, showers, fishing, hiking, amphitheater, 2 interpretive trails (1 accessible).

No motors allowed on lake. U.S. fee area.

Take Arkansas Hwy. 9 south from Perryville, AR for 9 miles; turn right (southwest) at sign on Arkansas Hwy. 324 for 4 miles. For more information, Call



Ouachita River Float Trip: The beautiful Ouachita River carries floaters easterly for a total of 45 miles. Tumbling through narrows and rapids at the float trip's beginning (near Pine Ridge, AR), it gradually slows to meander past massive rock bluffs at the lower end at Lake Ouachita.

Seven landings are usable, five of which are float camps.

Average floating speed is 1 mile per hour, varying with depth and season.

Good bass, bream, catfish, and walleye fishing.



SHIRLEY CREEK: Float camp on Ouachita River.

Camping (6 units), picnicking, vault toilet, fishing, canoe access.

Exit U.S. 270 at Pencil Bluff to State Hwy. 88, west 1 mile past the Oden Ranger Station, turn left on County Road 7991 for 1/2 mile.

ROCKY SHOALS: Float camp on Ouachita River.

Camping, float fishing, vault toilet, picnicking, canoeing, hiking.

Take U.S. 270 northwest from Mt. Ida, AR for 6 miles; turn right (north) just before crossing the Ouachita River Bridge (east side of river).

Womble Ranger District

FULTON BRANCH: Float camp on Ouachita River.

Camping, picnicking, float fishing, vault toilet, canoeing, hiking.

Take U.S. 270 northwest from Mt. Ida, AR for 4-1/2 miles to Arkansas Hwy. 298; turn right (north) for 1/2 mile to Forest Service Road 568; turn right (east) for 1-1/2 miles to Forest Service Road 1437.

Womble Ranger District

DRAGOVER: Float camp on Ouachita River.

Camping (7 units), picnicking, accessible vault toilet, float fishing, canoeing and drinking water.

From Pencil Bluff, AR take Arkansas Hwy. 88 east for 7 miles; turn south on County Road 97 for 1 mile.

Mena-Oden Ranger District

RIVER BLUFF: Float camp on Ouachita River.

Camping, picnicking, vault toilet, float fishing, canoeing, hiking.

From Mount Ida, AR; turn right (north) on Arkansas Hwy. 27 for 1/2 mile; turn left (northwest) on County Road 59 for 3-1/2 miles to Forest Service Road 138; turn left (north) for 2-1/2 miles.
