THE WINONA WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA

The Winona Wildlife Management Area covers 160,000 acres in Saline, Perry and Garland counties, almost all of it within the Ouachita National Forest.

State and federal game and fish laws are applicable to National Forest lands. Forest Service law enforcement officers enforce these laws.

Please see the latest Arkansas Hunting Guidebook for additional regulations that apply to the Forest. For more information, contact one of the Forest Service offices listed below.

CAMPING

Camping facilities are provided in designated sites. Some campgrounds require a fee.

Camping in primitive camp sites with no facilities is allowed on a first come/first served basis. Starting the day the camp is set up, campsite use is restricted to 30 days in undeveloped campsites and 14 days in developed campsites.

Undeveloped campsites may not be reserved by any method.

Camping or operating/parking motorized vehicles is not allowed in wildlife openings/food plots.

TOPOGRAPHIC MAPS

The red lines on the map on the other side show the outlines of the six USGS 7.5" Quad (topo) maps that cover the Winona Wildlife Management area. Note that a very small segment in the northwest corner is on a seventh map. These maps can be purchased at the Supervisor's Office in Hot Springs, by mail order or by phone.

Each map costs \$8.00 (includes tax).

Add \$3.50 for postage and handling to topographic map mail and phone orders (just one \$3.50-per-order charge, no matter how many topographic maps you order).




