Temporary Closure in Cedar Flats Area Partially Lifted

The Hungry Horse-Glacier View Ranger District of the Flathead National Forest has partially lifted the motorized vehicle closure in the Cedar Flats area north of Columbia Falls. Three routes remain closed because of continued wet and muddy conditions. The closed routes will be signed and District Ranger Jimmy DeHerrera urges motorized users to respect the closed routes. “These areas are still too wet for motorized travel and we want to protect them from further resource damage,” said DeHerrera.

Law Enforcement is patrolling the area and fines will be issued for those violating the remaining closures. To report motorized use along the closed routes or for more information contact Paula Peterson, Resource Assistant with the Hungry Horse-Glacier View Ranger District at 406-387-3818.
