Travel Delays on West-side Hungry Horse Reservoir Road

Travelers on the West-side Hungry Horse Reservoir Road, Forest Road #895, can expect temporary delays for the next few weeks as some culverts and a bridge are being replaced by the Flathead National Forest.

On Tuesday, July 21, travelers can expect up to 45 minutes delays as culverts are replaced on the West-side Hungry Horse Reservoir Road approximately 30 – 35 miles from the Hungry Horse Dam. Work in this area should be completed within a few days.

The bridge at Lost Johnny Creek on the West-side Reservoir Road is being replaced and temporary delays are expected through mid-August. This area is located approximately five miles south of Hungry Horse Dam.

For the next few weeks, all travelers on the West-side Hungry Horse Reservoir Road are urged to use caution as there are several crews working on the West-side Hungry Horse Reservoir Road.
