NEVADA BEACH ALCOHOL PROHIBITION
ZEPHYR COVE RESORT ALCOHOL PROHIBITION

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to protect public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit. This order is effective on July 4, 2007 from 8:00 am to 12 midnight.

1. Possessing a beverage which is defined as an alcoholic beverage under Nevada State law in the area known as Nevada Beach, as shown on Exhibit A.
36 CFR 261.58(bb).
2. Possessing a beverage which is defined as an alcoholic beverage under Nevada State law in the area known as Zephyr Cove Resort, as shown on Exhibit B.
36 CFR 261.58(bb).

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.



