LAKE TAHOE BASIN MANAGEMENT UNIT

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following is prohibited for the protection of property and special biological communities within the following described areas under my jurisdiction:

- (1) Allowing a dog to enter the area described on the attached map from March 15 to October 1.
[36 CFR 261.53(B)]
- (2) Discharging a firearm, air rifle, or gas gun within the posted boundary as shown on the attached map.
[36 CFR 261.58(M)]

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), each of the following persons is exempt from this order.

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (3) Persons engaged in a business, trade, or occupation in the area.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR, Part 261.

Done at South Lake Tahoe, California, this 18TH day of September, 1986.

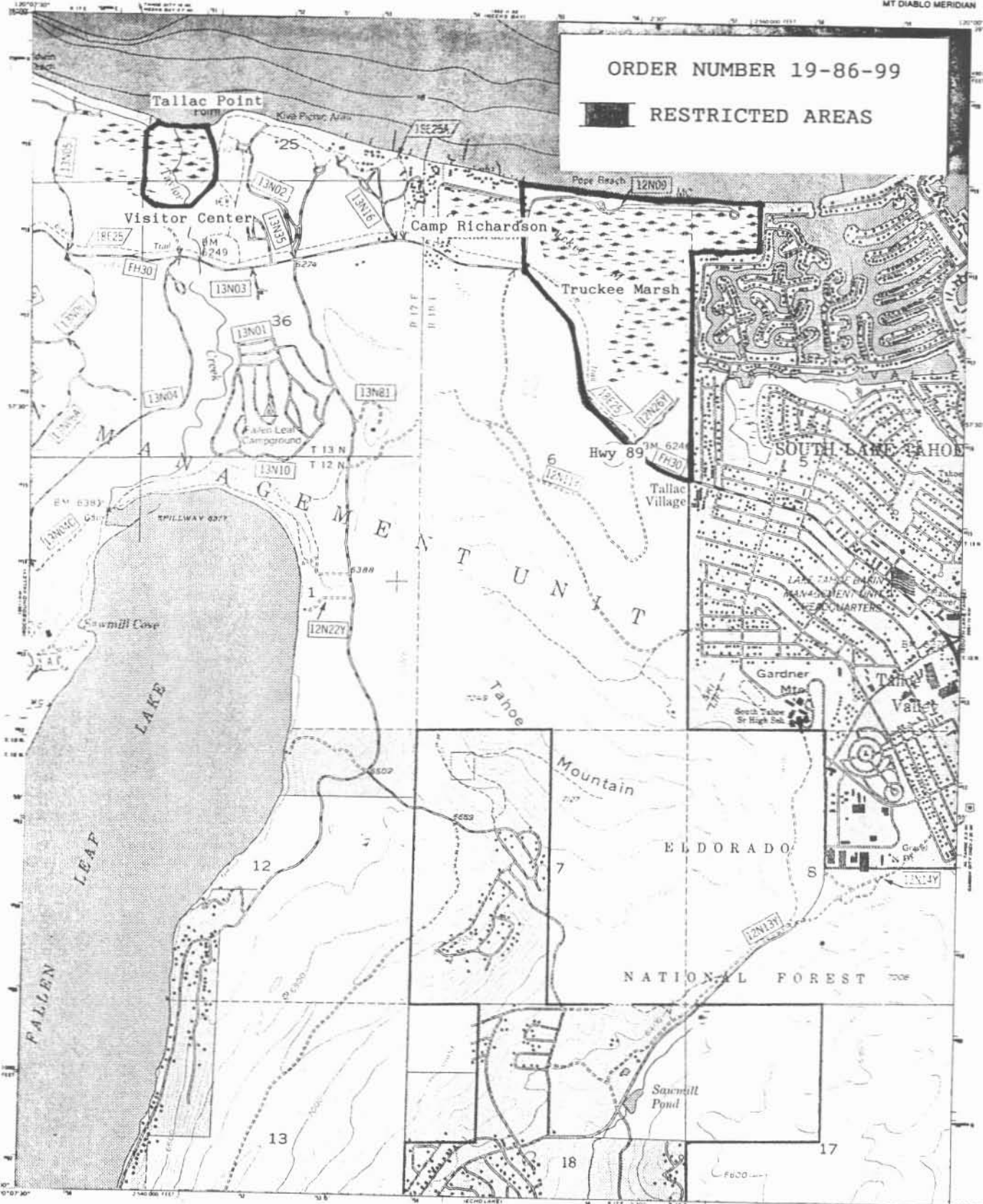

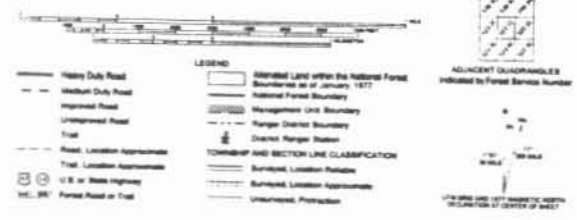
