**METAL DETECTORS CLOSURE
TALLAC HISTORIC SPECIAL INTEREST AREA**

LAKE TAHOE BASIN MANAGEMENT UNIT

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following is prohibited for the protection of the Tallac Historic Special Interest Area, as shown on the attached map, which is within my jurisdiction:

Entering into, or being within the area with a metal detector. 36 CFR 261.53(c)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), each of the following persons is exempt from this order.

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR, Part 261.

Done at South Lake Tahoe, California, this 3 day of May, 1989.
