I. INFORMATION SECTION

The Della Tebbs Pasture Allotment is located approximately 1.0 mile west of Panguitch Lake at the junction of the Panguitch Lake and Clear Creek roads. It encompasses approximately 5.0 acres of land which is all meadow. Also, there is a cabin located within the parcel of land on the north end. An irrigation ditch runs along the northwest side.

When the Tebbs' Ranch was fenced many years ago it wasn't fenced on the private land boundary but rather on a common boundary line which included some National Forest land in the ranch. A special use permit was issued in 1967 to cover this use. In 1973 the permit was terminated.

The entire 5.0 acres is suitable for livestock grazing. Range condition is fair and trend of vegetation and soil is stable. The grazing permit is issued to Della P. Tebbs Trust for six animal months under on and off provisions.

II. MANAGEMENT SECTION

The management objectives on this allotment are to maintain stable vegetation and soil conditions and graze the area in conformance with the Markagunt Land Use Plan.

On and off, season-long use will continue as long as the management objectives are being met.

The allotment is used in conjunction with private land. Livestock are put on the private land about May 15 and are normally removed about November 15. The grazing season will vary to some degree to meet forage conditions on the ground. Many years cattle will graze the area in late spring then will be taken off for a period of time before returning in late summer or fall.


The followup program will determine if the objectives are being met. If deterioration from grazing is resulting, one alternative will be to terminate the grazing permit and require the fence to be put on the actual private land boundary. The area would then be closed to grazing.

III. CORRELATION WITH OTHER USES

- A. Aesthetics - The parcel is located adjacent to the Panguitch Lake road. Grazing use on this area is similar to that on the private land that borders it. Therefore, aesthetic values will not be adversely affected.
- B. Recreation - Recreation values will not be affected by grazing on this area.

IV. FOLLOWUP

Allotment inspection will be made periodically to determine grazing impacts. The degree of early use, livestock grazing patterns and permittee management practices will be continually evaluated. If there is any indication of deterioration to the vegetation and/or soil, an alternative plan will be implimented.
