



TRAIL HEAD DIRECTIONS

Access to the Hell Point trail head is complex, so we have provided this special map and directions.

- A higher clearance vehicle is recommended due to some rough roads.

Drive N from Prescott on Hwy 89 (towards Ash Fork) to the jct with Verde Ranch Road (YC 137).

- This junction is about 18 miles from the airport, or just under 1 mile north of the rail road bridge at Paulden, and at mile post 338.3.

- From this junction to the TH, it is almost 12 miles. Turn right (east) onto YC 137 and drive to FR 681.

On YC 137, you will pass the following points:

- At 1.6 miles: the road becomes dirt at the rail road crossing, but is well maintained.
- At 4.2 miles: cattle guard marks forest boundary.
- At 7.9 miles: Y junction with FR 681 (sign at jct).
- **You are now on this map.**

Turn left (east) here and reset your odometer.

- The roads ahead are now narrower and rougher.

- The map shows the distances from YC 137.

- This will help you confirm you are doing OK!

- When you go through gates, reclose them.

You will reach the TH after 3.6 miles from YC 137.
