

**ORDER  
EMERGENCY FIRE CLOSURE  
PRESCOTT NATIONAL FOREST**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551, 36 CFR § 261.50(a), and 36 CFR § 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System lands within the Prescott National Forest, in the following counties with the state of Arizona, County of Yavapai (“the restricted area”). The restricted area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

**PROHIBITION:**

- ( 1 ) Going into or being upon the restricted area; 36 CFR § 261.52(e)

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this closure order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or Local Officer or member of an organized firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Resident owners, lessees of land, holders of Forest Service special use authorizations within the restricted area.

This Order is necessary to protect public health and safety due to the Lane 2 Fire burned area.

This Order becomes effective at 8:00 AM, July 15, 2008, and will remain in force until rescinded or until October 15, 2008, which ever occurs first. This Order rescinds, supersedes and revokes Order 09-184.

Violations of these regulations is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or both; 16 USC § 551, and 18 USC §§ 3559 and 3571.
