The Salmon/Challis National Forest is pursuing a detail opportunity for its GS-2101-11 Forest Aviation Officer position. This is a Not-To-Exceed (NTE) 120-days detail with an annual pay range between \$57,408 and \$74,628 (OPM 2012 Rates: GS 11 step 1 – GS 11 step 10). Travel to and per diem is authorized. The duty station will be at the Salmon/Challis National Forest Supervisors Office in Salmon, Idaho.

Duties

This position serves as the primary point of contact for aviation related activities on the Salmon/Challis National Forest, serves as a Level 3 Aviation COR for 5 exclusive use helicopter contracts, CWN light fixed wing, and CWN helicopter contracts. Other Duties include:

- Process Aviation Business System invoices and packages for payment for Forest contracts.
- Produce annual Forest Aviation Plan and briefing guide.
- Complete Project Aviation Safety Plans for all non-fire aviation activities on the Forest.
- Review all Safecomms on the Forest and document remedies.
- Coordinate prescribed fire, wildland fire operations and staffing on the Forest and with neighboring units.
- Coordinate annual aerial ignition refresher and helicopter manager workshops.
- Review and approve aerial ignition prescribed fire plans.
- Address performance and capability issues with pilots and aircraft as needed.
- Provide oversight and aviation resource coordination/prioritization with the aircraft desk at Central Idaho Interagency Dispatch Center.
- Ensure best cost and efficient use of aircraft resources when aviation assets are assigned.

About the Forest

The Salmon-Challis National Forest covers over 4.3 million acres in east-central Idaho. The Forest is bordered by the Bitterroot Range of the north-central Rockies on the east, and to the west includes over 1.3 million acres of the Frank Church-River of No Return Wilderness. Rugged and remote, this country offers adventure, solitude and breathtaking scenery. The Forest also contains Mt. Borah, Idaho's tallest peak and the Wild and Scenic Salmon River and Middle Fork of the Salmon River. The area is a highly desired destination for hunting, fishing, white-water rafting and many other recreation pursuits. It features diverse rough topography and geology, often severe weather conditions and miles of streams with anadromous fish spawning habitat creating a highly complex land management situation. The Forest Headquarters Office is located in Salmon, Idaho. There are currently six administrative units on the Forest: Salmon-Cobalt, Challis-Yankee Fork, Lost River, Middle Fork, North Fork and Leadore Ranger Districts.

Salmon, Idaho

The City: Salmon is the heart of the Salmon River Valley, surrounded by three mountain ranges and situated at the junction of Idaho State Highway 28 and U.S. Highway 93 and at the forks of the Salmon and Lemhi Rivers. The city has a population of about 3300 and is the seat of Lemhi County with a population of 8000. The main industries are ranching, mining and recreation. At 4000 feet elevation, the surrounding terrain varies greatly from rolling, arid hills to steep forested slopes above 10,000 feet.

Climate: Salmon enjoys a dry, warm climate during the summer and fall months with daily highs averaging between 75 and 95 degrees, and nightly lows from 45 to 60 degrees. The climate in the winter is ideal for snow sports, with high temperatures typically in the 20s and lower 30s and low temperatures averaging from 14 to 25 degrees with occasional sub-zero readings.

Medical: The City of Salmon has a new community hospital affiliated with the major hospital in Missoula, Montana and provides Life-Flight, EMT, Search and Rescue units, physicians, dentists, optometrists, and specialist affiliations with Western Montana Medical Clinic.

Recreation for Salmon and Challis Areas: The Salmon River and the Middle Fork of the Salmon River, federally protected as Wild and Scenic Rivers, are renowned for white-water rafting, kayaking, floating and jet-boating. Outfitter and Guide services are offered and both Salmon and Challis serve as gateways to the Frank Church-River of No Return Wilderness, encompassing more than 2.4 million acres. The primitive mountain area provides diverse hunting opportunities. Fishing (trout and steelhead) is open virtually all-year. Miles of groomed trails and routes are prepared for cross-country skiing and snowmobiling while downhill skiing, ice fishing and other winter fun can be enjoyed nearby.
