# Root Disease: *The Hidden Menace*

Unlike insect outbreaks and fires that can be highly visible, root diseases often go unnoticed, are typically more widespread, and have greater long-term impacts on forest health. In fact, root diseases are the primary tree killer on 2/3 of northern Idaho forests.

**Root Disease: *The Hidden Menace*** is aimed at forest managers and forest owners but is open to anyone who wishes to attend. The workshop will provide critical information needed to deal with root diseases. The program starts indoors discussing various root disease species and approaches to management, then ends with afternoons at field sites with root disease issues.
