Mount St Helens National Volcanic Monument-Alcohol and Food Prohibition

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the Gifford Pinchot National Forest in Cowlitz and Skamania County, Washington and as depicted on the attached maps until rescinded:

**Prohibition:**

- 1) **Possessing or storing any open food, or unsealed beverage is prohibited. 36 CFR 261.58 (cc).** See Exhibits C and E. Person(s) in possession of water are exempt.
- 2) **Possessing an open alcoholic beverage as defined by Washington State Law is prohibited. 36 CFR 261.58 (bb).** See Exhibits A, B, and D (attached).

**Exemptions:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:


- 1 Any Federal, State, County or Forest officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 2 Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

**Area Described:**

**Possessing or storing any open food, or unsealed beverage** is prohibited inside the Johnston Ridge Observatory building and inside the Mt St Helens Science and Learning Center building, except the Restaurant, Kitchen and Dining area. See Exhibits C & E.

**Open alcoholic beverage** is prohibited inside the Mt St Helens Science and Learning Center at Coldwater and the Johnston Ridge Observatory. See Exhibits B & D. Additionally, open alcohol is prohibited outside for 300-feet around all buildings (warehouse, residential area, etc...) and structures that are part of the Mt St Helens Science and Learning Center at Coldwater facility and the Johnston Ridge Observatory. This also includes the Hummock Boundary Trailhead parking lot, South Coldwater Trailhead parking lot and Loowit Trailhead parking lot and 300-feet from the center line of the road on both sides of State Highway 504 between Johnston Ridge Observatory and the Mt St Helens Science and Learning Center at Coldwater. See Exhibit A.


These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571)






