Klamath National Forest seeks public comment on OHV Grant Proposals

YREKA, CA – Interested members of the public are invited to attend a public meeting to make comment on two Off Highway Vehicle (OHV) riding area improvement project proposals. The meeting is scheduled for this Friday February 28, 2014 at 6:00 pm at the Klamath National Forest Supervisor's Office, 1711 S. Main Street, Yreka, CA. The Klamath National Forest is seeking funding from the California State Parks' Off Highway Motorized Vehicle Registration Division to fund the following projects:

- **Trail Maintenance on the Humbug motorized trail system:** This project proposes to perform maintenance on approximately 8.9 miles of motorized recreation trails and 1.4 miles of road in the Humbug OHV area on the Happy Camp-Oak Knoll district. This maintenance would improve public safety, improve recreation opportunities, and protect natural resources in the area.
- **Juniper Flat OHV Play Area improvements:** This proposal includes facilities construction to provide public safety, improve the recreation experience and help protect natural resources in the 48 acre OHV play area. In tandem with this project a Forest Service funded fuels reduction project within the riding area will reduce the risk of fire, improve visibility and provide for additional riding opportunities within the designated area.
