### RIM FIRE:

Portions of the Groveland Ranger District are closed to public use due to the Rim Fire (Forest Order STF-2013-15). Cherry Lake Road (1N07), Cottonwood Road (1N04), Lumsden Road (1N10) and other Forest Service roads within the burned area are closed.
