Funding will be available in 2014 for projects that provide benefits to National Forest lands in Trinity County. Successful proposals will perform work in:

Watershed Restoration
Road and Trail Maintenance
Fuels reduction
Wildlife and Fish Habitat Improvement

Improvement in forest ecosystem health
Control of noxious and exotic weeds
Soil productivity improvement
Re-establishment of native species

Proposals must demonstrate a benefit to Shasta-Trinity National Forest lands and are welcome from businesses, non-profit organizations, tribes, and government agencies.

Proposal deadline is **March 18, 2014**.
