****POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT****

Lincoln, Deer Lodge, and Helena Field Instructor Positions – YFMP

WHO: The Montana Discovery Foundation is announcing **3 openings** for **summer field instructors** in the **Youth Forest Monitoring Program**. This program teaches students concepts of forest ecosystems as well as monitoring techniques for streams, weeds, wildlife and soils at sites on the Helena and the Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forests.

WHAT: The summer field instructor position is responsible for supervising and transporting a team of 3 high school students to forest monitoring sites in the Helena, Lincoln, and Deer Lodge areas. The instructor supervises student time divided between outdoor fieldwork and indoor data analyses and reporting.

PAY: Field instructor will be paid \$11.50/hr.

WHERE: One position – Helena, MT One position – Deer Lodge, MT
One position – Lincoln, MT (lodging available)

WHEN: **The field instructor position runs June 3rd – August 1st, 2014.** The instructor is also requested to assist with student hiring in May for limited and flexible hours (1-2 afternoon/evenings). Two overnight stays are part of the position: Student training week June 16^h – 19th at Canyon Ferry Lake and a backpack trip into the Scapegoat Wilderness July 8th – 10th. Hours of work are Mondays – Thursdays 7:45am- 5:15pm, Fridays 9am – noon.

QUALIFICATIONS: The field instructor will have a current driver's license and clean driving record. Instructor must be able to attain a federal drivers' license and take Defensive Driver training. Science and/or education background requested. Computer knowledge and work experience with youth ages 14-18 required.

HOW: To apply, please submit letter of intent and brief resume. ****Be sure to indicate whether you are applying for the Helena, Lincoln, or Deerlodge-based Field Instructor Position.** Interviews will follow initial application process.
