**Forest AFMO wanted!** This is a non-competitive, not to exceed 120 days temporary promotion/detail opportunity, into a GS-301-11/12 position. The beginning date is June 1<sup>st</sup>, located at our Supervisor's Office in South Jordan, Utah. You will join a top-notch bunch of fire professionals and be in a key operational role in carrying out the forest's work in fire management, fuels, and aviation, and coordinating with our numerous interagency partners. We're looking for someone who is high-energy and innovative, likes a fast pace and challenging work, and enjoys working with diverse communities!

Located in northern Utah and southwestern Wyoming, the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest encompasses 2.3 million acres of spectacular scenery, unlimited recreation opportunities, nine wilderness areas, seven ranger districts, and borders both rural and urban communities.

There are many reasons for the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest to become your employer of choice!

**Here's the jist of the duties and responsibilities:** The Forest AFMO serves as the primary oversight individual for operational aspects of the fire and fuels program for the forest, and fills in for the Forest FMO in their absence. (See position descriptions numbered FS2108 & FS2109 for more detail) The fire and fuels organization includes 1 helibase (2 IA ships and 2 national ships), 1 airtanker base, 1 aviation officer, 7 engines, 2 IA handcrew modules, 5 prevention techs (4 zoned/1 forest), 2 ZFMOs, 5 ZAFMOs, 2 zone fuels specialists, 4 zone fuels techs, an interagency dispatch center and cache, 1 hotshot crew, a Job Corps fire program, a forest fuels Specialist, a fire ecologist, a training officer, and a fire planner. To qualify for this detail you will need to meet the FS-FPM minimums of DIVS and ICT3/RXB2, or ASGS and ICT3, plus completion of M-581.
