

## Summer Employment for Local Youth!

The Youth Conservation Corp (YCC) is a summer employment program for youths' ages 15-18 who will work, learn, and earn together in the great outdoors. The purpose of the YCC program is to accomplish needed conservation work on public Lands. The program is sponsored by the Pemigewasset Ranger District of the White Mountain National Forest, headquartered in Campton NH. The randomly selected crew will consist of 6 student; 50% boys and 50% girls. Enrollees will work a 40 hour week earning minimum wage and will be involved with the following conservation activities: trail maintenance, clean-up and maintenance of recreation sites and parking areas, wildlife habitat improvement work, and other special projects supporting Timber and Fire management. The YCC crew will also spend one day a week learning about natural resource conservation and management during dedicated education days. This 8 week program will run from the end of June to the middle of August.
