**INTEGRATED RESOURCE TIMBER CONTRACT - STEWARDSHIP**

**WILLAMETTE NATIONAL FOREST**

The 7 Thin Reoffer Integrated Resource Timber Contract is located within section(s) 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, & 27, T16S. R4E., W. M., unsurveyed, Lane County, Oregon. The Forest Service will receive technical and price proposals (no public opening) at the Willamette National Forest Headquarters, 3106 Pierce Parkway, Suite D, Springfield, Oregon 97477, no later than 10:00 AM, on or before May 19, 2014 for an estimated volume of 7,075 Tons of Douglas-fir and other coniferous species saw timber marked or otherwise designated for cutting. There is within the contract area an unestimated volume of biomass material that the bidder may agree to remove at a fixed rate. Also included in the contract are two (2) mandatory restorative service projects to be completed by the Contractor. The contract will be awarded based on a Best Value determination. One award will be made to the Offeror, (a) whose proposal is technically acceptable, and (b) whose technical/price relationship is the most advantageous to the Government. The Forest Service reserves the right to reject any and all technical and price proposals.
