




## Directions to Williams RD Paid Personal Use Green Fuelwood Cutting Areas



There are four (4) areas on the Williams Ranger District for cutting green fuelwood. All units are signed and unit boundaries are painted with pink, unless otherwise noted. Directions provided below are from the Williams Ranger District. Cross-country travel is authorized in all four green fuelwood cutting units with the possession of a paid personal use fuelwood permit.

### Unit 4G:

*Species:* Juniper

*Vehicles:* High clearance required (rocky)

#### *Directions from Williams Ranger Station:*

1. Drive North on S Clover Rd- (0.1 miles)
2. Turn right onto Frontage Rd-(0.2 miles).
3. Turn left onto Historic U.S. 66 W-(0.6 miles)
4. Turn left onto I-40 W-(13 miles)
5. Take exit 14B, FR 9371B, toward County Line Rd.-(0.2 miles)
6. Continue straight as road becomes native surface. (1.9 miles)
7. Follow right onto FR 9731A, toward County Line Rd. (0.2 miles)
8. Turn right onto FR 796 (0.1 miles)
9. Wood is available immediately to the right once entering the signed unit boundary at the tree line. Green juniper trees may be cut in this area up to a 14 inch diameter at root collar (DRC), (44 inch circumference).

### Unit 8G:

*Species:* Juniper

*Vehicles:* Low/high clearance ok (rocky w/ good access)

#### *Directions from Williams Ranger Station:*

1. Drive North on S Clover Rd- (0.1 miles)
2. Turn right onto Frontage Rd-(0.2 miles).
3. Turn left onto Historic U.S. 66 W-(0.6 miles)
4. Merge right onto I-40 E-(6 miles)
5. Take Parks exit 172 (N)-(16 miles)
6. Turn left (N) onto the Garland Prairie Rd-(0.2 miles)
7. Turn left (W) onto Route 66-(0.5 miles)
8. Turn right (N) onto Spring Valley Rd/FR 141-(9 miles).
9. Follow transition onto FR 144-(1mile).
10. The available cutting area is on the left side (W) of FR 144 North to FR 736 (AT&T line). Green juniper trees may be cut in this area up to a 12 inch diameter at root collar (DRC), (38 inch circumference).

### **Unit 6G:**

**Species:** Juniper

**Vehicles:** Low/high clearance ok (rocky w/ good access)

#### ***Directions from Williams Ranger Station:***

11. Drive North on S Clover Rd- (0.1 miles)
12. Turn right onto Frontage Rd-(0.2 miles).
13. Turn right onto Historic U.S. 66 W-(1.2 miles)
14. Turn right onto S 4th St.-(0.3 miles)
15. Turn right onto FR 173AA-(13 miles)
16. The available cutting area is 300' off of the paved road. Green juniper trees may be cut in this area up to a 18 inch diameter at root collar (DRC), (56 inch circumference).

### **Unit 7G:**

**Species:** Juniper

**Vehicles:** Low/high clearance ok (rocky w/ good access)

#### ***Directions from Williams Ranger Station:***

17. Drive North on S Clover Rd- (0.1 miles)
18. Turn right onto Frontage Rd-(0.2 miles).
19. Turn right onto Historic U.S. 66 W-(1.2 miles)
20. Turn right onto S 4th St.-(0.3 miles)
21. Turn right onto FR 44-(18 miles)
22. The available cutting area can be accessed 300' from the paved road to the right. Green juniper trees may be cut in this area up to a 18 inch diameter at root collar (DRC), (56 inch circumference).
