



Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest Resource Advisory Committee

Individuals are being sought to represent a variety of interests on the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest Resource Advisory Committee (RAC).

- The RAC is authorized through the Secure Rural Schools Act as a mechanism for local community collaboration with federal land managers.
- Committee members meet at least twice a year to review, recommend, and monitor approved projects
- Projects are funded based on national forest receipts through the Secure Rural Schools Acts
- Members serve a four-year, voluntary term and are appointed by the Secretary of Agriculture
- Members must reside in the State of Utah

Positions are available in the following categories:

Category A - Developed outdoor recreation, Off-Highway Vehicle Users, or Commercial Recreation Activities; Land-use Permit Holder; Commercial Timber Industry; Energy and Mineral Development; Alternate (can be in any of the sub categories)

Category B - Archaeology and History; Wildlife or Hunting Organizations or Watershed Associations; Dispersed Recreational Activities; nationally, regionally, or locally recognized environment organization. Alternate (can be in any of the sub categories)

Category C - State-elected Official; County or Local-elected Official; Tribal Representative; School Officials or Teachers; Alternate (can be in any of the sub categories)
