

**ORDER  
USDA - FOREST SERVICE  
COCONINO NATIONAL FOREST  
USE OF VEHICLES OVER RESTRICTED BRIDGES**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (b) the following acts are prohibited on the Coconino National Forest on National Forest System Roads within Coconino County in the State of Arizona, as depicted in on the attached maps titled Exhibits A, B, and C.

**PROHIBITIONS on the Restricted Roads:**

1. Operating a vehicle in violation of speed, load, weight, length, or width limitations as posted on National Forest System Roads within the restricted area; **36 CFR 261.54 (d)**.

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit or authorization specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

**RESTRICTED AREA DESCRIBED:**

This order affects the following bridges on National Forest lands: Walnut Canyon Creek Bridge (load ratings: 3 Rating-10 tons, 3S2 Rating-15 tons, 3-3 Rating-19 tons), Beaver Creek South Bridge (load ratings: 3 Rating-16 tons, 3S2 Rating-24 tons, 3-3 Rating-32 tons) , and West Fork Bridge (load ratings: 3 Rating-15 tons, 3S2 Rating-23 tons, 3-3 Rating-29 tons) . The Walnut Canyon Creek Bridge is located approximately 0.1 miles on FSR 651 from Coconino County Road 3 on Coconino National Forest Flagstaff Ranger District in T19N, R9E, Section 16 (See Exhibit A). The Beaver Creek South Bridge is located approximately 2.5 miles on FSR 618 from State Route 179 on Coconino National Forest Red Rock Ranger District in T15N, R6E, Section 28 (See Exhibit B). The West Fork Bridge is located at approximately MP 18.4 on FSR 231 where the road crosses the West Fork of Oak Creek on Coconino National Forest Flagstaff Ranger District in T19N, R5E, Section 15 (See Exhibit C).

**PURPOSE:**

This order is needed to ensure public health and safety and the structural integrity of bridges on the roads within the restricted area.

**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until March 7, 2016 or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.
2. This Order rescinds, replaces and supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order in areas addressed by Exhibit A.



