**LUMPY-TUNG FUELS PROJECT: AREA AND TRAILS CLOSURE**

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) § 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on all National Forest System land and trails within the Magnolia area on the Boulder Ranger District of the Roosevelt National Forest, Boulder County, State of Colorado (the "Restricted Area" and the "Restricted Trails").

The Restricted Area and the Restricted Trails are defined as that Area and those Trails east of Colorado Highway 72/119 and north of County Road 132, T1S, R73W, Sections 13 and 24, and T1S, R72W sections 18 and 19, 6<sup>th</sup> Principle Meridian. The closure is shown on the attached map, hereby included in this Order as Exhibit A. County Road 132 (Magnolia Road), National Forest System Road 552 (Peak View Road) and National Forest System Road 958 will remain open to public traffic within the closure area.

This Order is necessary to ensure public safety while implementing the Tungsten Fuels Treatment Project.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System Lands within the Restricted Area. 36 C.F.R. § 261.53(e),
2. Using any type of vehicle within the Restricted Area. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e)
3. Being on a Trail within the Restricted Area. 36 C.F.R. § 261.55(a).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force engaged in the performance of an official duty;
2. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission; and
3. Persons travelling through the Restricted Area on County Road 132 (Magnolia Road), National Forest System Road 552 (Peak View Road) and National Forest System Road 958 are exempt from the Prohibitions as long as they remain on the exempted roadways.

This Order will be in effect and when posted and signed on the ground and shall remain in effect until rescinded or until midnight March 31, 2015, whichever event occurs first.
