

Step-by-step: Getting the Coconino Travel Map on your iPhone or iPad*

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You can now get a color version of the 2014 MVUM with shaded relief, hiking trails, hunt unit boundaries, and more on your iPhone or iPad. The best part about this is it is **FREE** and it is GPS-active, meaning you can see where you are when driving or hiking on the Coconino National Forest.



Get the app – Touch **App Store** on the device (icon shown on right). Touch the search tab, and type in “pdf maps”. **Avenza PDF Maps** app will come up (icon shown on right). Touch “Free” and then “Install”. You will need to type in your Apple password.



Get the map – Once the **Avenza PDF Maps** app has installed, you can scan the QR code on the right to get the maps.



← Scan for the north half. This will open the map in your browser. Once it has loaded, tap once on the map. In the upper left hand corner you will see “Open in...” Tap on this text and tap on the PDF Maps icon (above, right). If the map doesn’t begin to load in the PDF Maps App, try again. If there isn’t enough memory on your phone for the map, you will need to delete one or more other maps in PDF Maps before it will load.
 ← Once the north half loads, repeat for the south half.

If you do not have a QR code scanner, open PDF Maps and touch the “Maps” tab at the bottom or top of the screen. Then touch the **+** symbol in the upper right corner. There will be a box at the bottom of the screen that says, “Type or Paste URL here”.

- To download the North half of the forest, type in <http://db.tt/wDUpn1vk> (case sensitive). Once typed, the map will start to download automatically.
- To download the South half type in <http://db.tt/gApM5FLw> (case sensitive).

Get going! – Touch a map’s entry on the **Maps** page to open it. WiFi or 3G/4G coverage is not required to use the map, as all map content is saved on the device. Users may pan, zoom out, zoom in, place waypoints, record GPS tracks, or plot photos. GPS positioning is active when this blue dot  is displayed on-screen.

Keep current! Please keep current and upload the most recent map. These instructions are for the map released April 15, 2014. A new map is released around April 15 of each year.
