TEMPORARY AREA CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and Title 36 CFR 261.50 (b), the following act is prohibited on the road described in this order, and depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this order as Exhibit A, all within the Douglas Ranger District, Coronado National Forest, Cochise County, Arizona:

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Being on Forest Service Road 357, also known as Pine Canyon Road, with any motorized vehicle. 36 CFR 261.54(a)

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

Approximately 2.9 miles of Forest Service Road 357, also known as Pine Canyon Road, between the barricades set at Barfoot Park and Methodist Camp Road. This area is located in T17S, R 30 E, Sections 30, 31, 32 and 33.

PURPOSE:

To allow for public safety in Pine Canyon, west of Barfoot park and east of the Methodist Church Camp following flooding and erosion in an area affected by the Horseshoe II fire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order shall be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until September 30, 2014, or until rescinded, whichever is earlier.
2. This Order supersedes, rescinds, and replaces any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this order.
3. Any violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for individuals and \$10,000.00 for organizations and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b) (6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b) (7)].
