**ORDER NO. 12-02-14**

**CLOSURE FOR PUBLIC SAFETY AND HEALTH  
"Pinch-em Tight Fire Area"**

Pursuant to the provisions of 16 U.S.C., Section 551, and Title 36 C.F.R., Section 261.50 (a), the following prohibitions apply to the **"Pinch-em Tight Fire Area"** located on the Cumberland Ranger District of the Daniel Boone National Forest in both Powell and Wolfe County. The area is signed closed from the edge of Rough Trail #221, to the edge of Sheltopee Trace Trail #100, and down through the drain. The area is all the burnt black area of the fire. The area in question is depicted on the attached map.

**Going into or upon National Forest Lands known as the Pinch-em Tight Fire Area site  
261.53 (e)**

The above prohibited act is set forth in Title 36 C.F.R., Section 261.53.

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(e) the following persons are exempt from the above Prohibition:

Any Federal, State or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force engaged in the performance of an official duty.

Any authorized person engaged in official administrative duties regarding National Forest Administration.

**ORDER EXPIRES 120 DAYS FROM DATE OF SIGNATURE**

Violations of the above prohibition set forth are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or both. See 16 U.S.C. 551, 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571.

CIVIL RIGHTS:

Major civil rights impacts are those consequences of proposed policy actions that, if implemented, would negatively and disproportionately affect groups or classes of people by virtue of their race, color, sex, national origin, age, religion, family status, or disability. The deciding officer has considered the impact of this proposal (to prohibit going into or upon National Forest land on the Pinch-em Tight Fire area, the civil rights of minorities, women, persons with disabilities, and other protected groups. In considering the effects of the proposed action, it was determined that the civil rights of any protected group or class of people would not be affected by this closure.

NEPA JUSTIFICATION:


This action is consistent with FSH 1909 31.11 and 31.12 and the 2004 Revised Land and Resource Management Plan, Daniel Boone National Forest. No extraordinary circumstances exist that might cause the action to have significant environmental effects. Therefore, this action is categorically excluded from documentation in an environmental assessment or environmental impact statement. No additional NEPA documentation is required to proceed with implementation of this Order.
