

- PFFPP South Timber Sale (no cutting)
PFFPP = "Plateau Facilities Fire Protection Project"
- Zydeco 1 & 2 Salvage Sales (no cutting)

Travel Management Rule:


Brown Areas on Map:

No Motorized Vehicles Allowed beyond 30 feet along public roads within the pinyon pine and juniper.

White Areas on Map (within District boundary):

In ponderosa pine, aspen, spruce and/or fir don't drive beyond 30' feet off roads to look for wood. However, if wood has been located by hiking, horseback or by seeing it from the roads, Permittees can drive to the wood, making 1 trip in and 1 trip out beyond 30'.

Other restricted "no cutting" areas not shown include: campgrounds, communication sites, administration sites or temporary restricted areas as posted.
