## SHASTA-TRINITY NATIONAL FOREST

### American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Accomplishments

#### **ARRA Projects 58-332 and 58-333**

These were a roadside vegetation maintenance project in the Shasta Lake area. Project activities included cutting of brush and small trees along Forest Service roads to improve public access and safety on those roads, as well as increasing the effectiveness of fire suppression efforts and reducing fuels.

Methods to accomplish these goals included cutting/mastication of brush and small trees and hand clearing of debris from culverts. The intent was to obtain a spacing of no greater than 25 feet between remaining trees. The lower branches of the retained trees have been removed to a height of up to 10 feet. Any hazard trees that could have fallen on the roadway have been cut and left on the site. Some of the cut trees were stacked next to the road for the public to gather as firewood. Other woody material was mulched or piled and burned or used as fish habitat in Shasta Lake.
