American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Accomplishments

ARRA 51-183

The “Jobs Partnership and Community Wildfire Protection Project” had a simple, though important, goal. It was designed to remove small trees and brush that have grown over or fallen on the following trails; Humboldt (09W36), French Ranch (7E30), South Fork National Recreation (8E18), Brooks Ridge (10W40), Chicago Camp (10W39) and Devil’s Hole (10W42). Some of the trees near the trails had died and could have potentially fallen on the trail, so were an obvious hazard that needed removal.

All material was cut and left on site. Light maintenance was done to the trail itself.
