American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Accomplishments



ARRA 54-343 and 56-324

The “Jobs Partnership and Community Wildfire Protection Project” name is used several times in these descriptions to label the same worthwhile work in several places on the forest. In this case, near the towns of Weaverville and Big Bar, along many county and Forest Service roads. The work consists of cutting small trees and brush to promote public access and safety. Other goals included increasing fire suppression effectiveness and providing firewood to the public. Woody material that was not made available as firewood was ‘masticated’ to mulch (imagine a very large lawn mower) and spread over the area.
