

## Install The 2014 Personal-Use Fuelwood Map On Your Smartphone Or Tablet

### Step 1 - Install the PDF Maps app

- A. Use your smartphone or tablet to visit the **Google Play Store** (for Android 4.0.3+ devices) or the **Apple App Store** (for Apple iOS 5.0+ devices).
- B. Search for and install the free “**Avenza PDF Maps**” app. Its icon looks like this.



### Step 2 – Install the fuelwood map

- A. If your smartphone or tablet has a QR code scanner app, scan this QR code, touch “**Open**” (or something similar), and wait for the map to download and process.
- B. If your device does not have a QR code scanner app, you have two choices.
  1. Visit the **Google Play Store** or the **Apple App Store** and install a free “**QR code**” scanner app. Then follow step 2A.
  2. Open the device’s browser, like Safari (on Apple) or Chrome (on Android), and enter this URL: <http://go.usa.gov/kj49>.
    - If you used an Apple device, wait for the download to complete. Then:
      - Touch the upper right-hand corner of the map
      - Touch “**Open In...**”
      - Touch “**Open In PDF Maps**”, and wait for the file to process
    - If you used an Android device, wait for the download to complete. Then:
      - Browse to the device’s “**Download**” folder
      - Touch the file named “**stelprdb5415596.pdf**”
      - Touch “**PDF Maps**”, and wait for the file to process



### Step 3 – Use the map

Touch the map’s entry on the **Maps** page to open it. WiFi or 3G/4G coverage is not required to use the map because it has been saved on the device. You can zoom in, zoom out, and move the map around using standard multi-touch gestures.

Touch the arrow button until it looks like this  (Apple devices) or like this  (Android devices) to activate the GPS, and keep the map centered on the GPS position. The GPS is active when this blue dot  is visible on the screen.
