

Forest Plan Content

- Sensitive and rare plants
- Peregrine eyries
- Other sensitive wildlife
- BMPs for soil, water, riparian vegetation

Wilderness


- Loop hikes expanded
- Low impact day use
- No trails in Primitive and Pristine

Neighborwoods

- Connections around Sedona and VOC
- Mitigate neighborhood-recreation conflicts

House Mountain-Lowlands AKA Savannah

- Low density
- Wide variety of trail uses



Site Specific Resource “Filters”

- Threatened, endangered and sensitive species
- Wilderness Act (WOS)
- Research Natural Areas and Botanical Areas
- Heritage sites
- Tribal consultation
- Clean Water Act, wetlands and floodplains
- Sensitive soils and erosion
