Dispatch Operating Guidelines



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INTRODUCTION

The intent of this plan is to facilitate centralized dispatching within the Payette National Forest protection area as identified in the Payette Fire Management Plan. This plan identifies Payette Dispatch's initial response to fires as specified by fire managers.

Centralized dispatch is a process intended to reduce redundancy and streamline dispatching of resources. It is intended to relieve the Districts of dispatch related duties and allow them to concentrate on incident management decisions. It is also intended to increase consistency in dispatching of resources across the Forest and to define a quantitative preplanned approach to the dispatching of resources.

The Forest is broken out into 39 Response Areas. Fire managers have developed Run Cards (see pages 13-51) for each of these Response Areas. The Run Cards establish the Dispatch priorities and the type of resource needed for each Dispatch Level. The Dispatch Levels of Green (low), Yellow (moderate) and Red (high) are adjusted daily according to pre-established fire business break points of the Energy Release Component (ERC).

All of the Run Cards are programmed in to the WildCAD dispatching program. Based on this information, WildCAD identifies the number and type of resources to be dispatched to each Response Area at a given Dispatch Level. Dispatchers will send the appropriate available resources as identified by WildCAD.

Resource availability is communicated to Payette Dispatch by the Zone Duty Officer using the Resource Status program. This information is used to correctly status resources in WildCAD. If a resource is not statused as "available" in WILDCAD it will not be dispatched in the initial tone out.

Because ground resources (engines and crews) change their physical location during the day, they will call Payette Dispatch with their physical location and the Response Area that they are working in. Payette Dispatch will change the resources location in WildCAD to that Response Area.

Aircraft locations will not be changed in WildCAD unless the aircraft is prepositioned to a new base for an operational shift.

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DISPATCH PROCEDURES

- Initial smoke reports are reported directly to Payette Dispatch.
- Payette Dispatch will assign the smoke report a number (generated by WildCAD).
- A tone alert over the radio will be used to alert zones of the smoke report. After the tone Payette Dispatch will identify the responding unit(s) and give a lat/long or legal description. Payette Dispatch will contact each responding unit to confirm the message is received.
- The appropriate resources as defined on the Run Card will be dispatched. Some situations warrant calling the Zone Duty Officer before a resource is sent.
- Payette Dispatch will notify the Zone Duty Officer of the incident and validate the number and type of resource responding.
- The Incident Commander will relay a fire size up to Payette Dispatch.
- Dispatch will verify the location and assign an incident name using closest geographical location.
- Requests for additional resources and logistical needs will be made to Payette Dispatch.
- The Incident Commander will update Payette Dispatch whenever conditions change, and at the beginning and end of each shift every day.
- Payette Dispatch will ensure the Zone Duty Officer is current on any changing fire conditions.
- Payette Dispatch will coordinate demobilization of the fire with the Zone Duty Officer.
- Fire priorities will be established between the Forest, Zone and Dispatch Duty Officers.

ZONE OUT PROCEDURES

- Payette Dispatch will broadcast a tone out on East and West repeat using the tone best suited to reach the responding resources.
- After the tone, Payette Dispatch will list all resources to respond and then pause for a 3 count. Aircraft will not be listed by tail number but by type and responding base.
- After the pause, Payette Dispatch will broadcast the incident number and legal description of the incident.
- Payette Dispatch will call out to the first responding ground resource and ensure that they copied the transmission, then continue down the list of responding ground resources and ensure all copied.
- Responding ground resources will call in to Payette Dispatch when they are en-route and provide an ETE.
- Dispatch will fax an aircraft dispatch form to the responding aircraft base. Upon receipt, that base will identify which tail number will respond.

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- Payette Dispatch will relay the responding aircrafts tail number to the responding ground resources.

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FIRE FOLDERS, INCIDENT ORGANIZERS AND FIRESTAT

After a fire is declared out and demobilized, the Incident Commander will complete the Incident Organizer and Fire Report and submit it to the district that the fire was in. Payette Dispatch will email a copy of the WildCAD incident to all Zone Duty Officers, one of whom will complete the fire report in Firestat as directed in FSH 5109.14.

EXTENDED STAFFING

Dispatch will coordinate with Duty Officers on extended staffing needs. Decision to staff outside normal work schedules will be based on:

- Past and forecasted lightning
- Person Caused Risk (weekend and holiday)
- Red flag warning or fire weather watch
- National Fire Danger Rating Indices
- Neighboring units needs
- Geographical area needs On-
- going fire support needs

The dispatcher for each Zone will contact the appropriate Zone Duty Officer 30 minutes before the normal close of business and ask if they have any extended staffing needs. Dispatch will relay any extensions over the radio and via phone. If the Forest Duty Officer determines a need for extended staffing, dispatch will relay that information to the Zone Duty Officer.

PAYETTE DISPATCH AFTER HOURS STAFFING PROTOCOLS AND OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES

Payette Dispatch will be the 24 hour primary contact for all resources assigned to incidents. The 24 hour phone number is 208-634-XXXX.

- Dispatch will normally be staffed during fire season (June through September) with a Night Dispatcher. When Dispatch is not staffed the following procedures will be followed:
- Upon close of business each evening, a communication link will be established between assigned resources on an incident and the on-call dispatcher. Lookouts and cellular telephones may be utilized to establish this link.
- If unable to establish this link, Payette Dispatch will maintain overnight staffing.
- If a fire is reported to a Zone Duty Officer after hours, that duty officer will contact the on-call dispatcher. The Zone Duty Officer will

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determine whether to staff the fire that evening or wait until the next morning.

- If a fire is reported to Dispatch after hours, Dispatch will notify the appropriate Zone Duty Officer. The Zone Duty Officer will determine whether to staff the fire that evening or wait until the next morning.
- The Zone Duty Officer will contact resources that will respond to the incident. Once the resources have reported to station, and are ready to respond, they will contact Payette Dispatch for any new or pertinent information before responding.

LIGHTNING PLAN

Lightning is the major source of fire activity on the Payette National Forest, and multiple fire starts in the same day are common. Payette Dispatch is responsible for centralized wildland fire dispatching for the Payette National Forest and the impact of multiple lightning caused fires can be very significant. The Lightning Plan was developed to handle multiple fire starts occurring from lightning storms.

ACTIVATION OF THE PLAN

1. Activation of the Lightning Plan will occur when several of the following conditions exists, keeping in mind there could be outside influences or local conditions that will call for plan activation.
2. Guidelines for Activation:
 - Current tempo of new fire starts results in insufficient resources available to continue use of pre-planned WildCAD run cards.
 - Additional lightning is imminently forecasted or occurring.
 - Additional off-unit resources are required, and are being staged for initial attack.
 - Demand for logistical support for on-going fires is high, and can be more efficiently managed by a Zone.
3. The Forest Duty Officer will make the determination for activation of the Lightning Plan after consultation with the Dispatch and Zone Duty Officers. Once the decision has been made to activate the Lightning Plan, Payette Dispatch will notify all field units by radio broadcast that the lightning plan has been activated for that Zone.

OPERATING PROCEDURES

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1. In Lightning Plan, the Zone Duty Officer will maintain close communication with Payette Dispatch to direct suppression response for new fire starts. Payette Dispatch will maintain centralized

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dispatching for all incidents on the three Zones; however WildCAD pre-planned run cards will typically not be used to mobilize resources.

2. The Zone Duty Officer will set priorities and direct Payette Dispatch to mobilize resources based on suppression goals and objectives contained within the Payette FMP. In multiple fire situations, there are often insufficient resources available to continue using WildCAD pre-planned run cards. As such, the Zone Duty Officer will set priorities for suppression response, and will make the decisions on tactical deployment of resources to be carried out by Payette Dispatch.
3. Payette Dispatch will continue to mobilize resources and provide a link to maintain command and control between Incident Commanders and the Zone Duty Officers. Dispatch will continue to be the reporting location for all new starts, aircraft flight following, tactical and logistical support needs from the incidents, and size up or situational updates from the Initial Attack Incident Commanders.
4. Every effort will be made to maintain close communications between the Zone Duty Officer and Payette Dispatch.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Zone Duty Officer

- Consult with the Forest and Dispatch Duty Officers on activation of Lightning Plan.
- Set overall priorities for fires on the zone, and direct tactical deployment of resources through assigned dispatcher.
- Maintain close communication with Payette Dispatch.
- Ensure District Line Officers and Zone resources are informed of fire situation.
- Order additional resources thru Payette Dispatch if local resource shortage is anticipated.
- Organize zone resources into appropriate initial attack or extended attack organizations.
- Set up logistical organization to support multiple fire activity, on-going and anticipated fires.
- Ensure Payette Dispatch is informed of all suppression actions taken or any pre-positioning of resources. Inform Payette Dispatch of any extended/additional staffing needs for their zone.

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2. Incident Commander

- Report fire size-up directly to Payette upon arrival on the fire.
- Request all tactical and logistical orders through Payette Dispatch.

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- Provide real time report on conditions and fire situation updates through Dispatch; including containment, control, and demobilization plans.

3. Payette Dispatch:

- Provide centralized dispatching during Lightning Plan.
- Receive initial fire reports and assign WildCAD incident numbers.
- Initiate WildCAD for incident tracking and documentation, but base tactical deployment of resources on direction from the Zone Duty Officer instead of pre-planned WildCAD run cards.
- Tone-out resources to respond to incidents as directed by the Zone Duty Officer.
- Maintain WildCAD records and incident logs for all incidents.
- Process all tactical and logistical support requests from the individual Incident Commanders.
- Ensure the Zone Duty Officer is provided with up to date information on all new starts or fire situation updates from on-going fires.
- Notify the Forest Duty Officer and Zone Duty Officer when Payette Dispatch is experiencing difficulty to keep-up with tempo of new starts and on-going incidents.
- Coordinate all aircraft requests for Air Attack/Detection flights, retardant, lead planes, and smokejumpers.
- Provide flight following for all tactical aircraft.

4. Forest Duty Officer:

- Keep abreast of the complete situation and monitor organizational expansion. Serve as "Area Commander" by setting priorities for use of critical resources, national shared resources, and set priorities between incidents if they cannot be resolved.
- Oversee operations and be available for consultation from Zone Duty Officers.
- Ensure Forest Supervisor is informed of fire situation and activation of Lightning Plan.
- Coordinate with cooperators.
- Monitor fire protocol and provide support as necessary.
- Facilitate additional Zone Duty Officers and logistical support between affected zones.

LIGHTNING PLAN DEACTIVATION

In deactivating the Lightning Plan, command, and control of initial attack

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will revert to Payette Dispatch, and all centralized dispatching operating plans as described will resume. Prior to deactivation of the Lightning Plan the following guidelines should be met:

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- Sufficient IA resources will be in place and available for a return to centralized dispatching using pre-planned WildCAD run cards.
- The decision to deactivate the Lightning Plan will be made jointly between the Zone, Forest and Dispatch Duty Officers.
- Any out of area resources should be considered for release.
- Payette Dispatch will announce over the radio that the Zone has gone out of the Lightning Plan, and to resume centralized dispatching.

PRESCRIBED FIRE DISPATCH PROCEDURES

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Burn Boss

- Notify Payette Dispatch of planned burns. For aerial ignition burns notify dispatch at least one week in advance.
- Provide dispatch with header information for any spot requests.
- Complete smoke reporting requirements.
- Inform dispatch of resources committed on project from their zone, through the Resource Status Program or by phone.
- Order additional resources through Payette Dispatch.
- Request spot forecasts from Payette Dispatch.
- Keep Payette Dispatch informed of progress.
- Notify dispatch of staffing needs 1 day prior to the prescribed burn.
- Ensure Dispatch knows when extended staffing is needed
- Report completed acres to Dispatch daily.
- Ensure current Burn Plan is available on the O Drive
- Long duration burns need to be planned at least two weeks in advance.

2. Payette Dispatch

- Verify copy of Burn Plan is on the O drive and contains Medivac Plan and Notification List.
- Make appropriate notifications as specified in Burn Plan.
- Record burn information and create Prescribed Fire Incident in WildCAD.
- Generate incident in ROSS and commit appropriate resources.
- Verify Zones have updated burn information in SMU.
- Status resources just as we would during normal fire season.
- Process orders for any additional resource requests from the burn bosses.
- Process and read spot requests.

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Document all communication with the Burn Boss in WildCAD.
Staff the office until the Burn Boss releases dispatch for evening.

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
- Keep Forest Duty Officer and/or Zone Duty Officer updated.
- Forward any complaints or public comments to the Airshed Coordinator

3. Zone Duty Officer


- Coordinate with Burn Boss and update Resource Status daily.
- Keep updated on progress of burn.

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PAYETTE DISPATCH BREAKPOINTS




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Green Dispatch Level – ERC = 0 - 39
