

ORDER NO. 14-08

**SEQUOIA NATIONAL FOREST**

**FIRE RESTRICTIONS**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety and protect natural resources, the following acts are prohibited within the Sequoia National Forest. This Order is effective from May 21, 2014, through the end of the official 2014 fire season.

1. Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire, except within the areas listed in Exhibits A-C and Big Meadows Area, shown on Exhibit D. 36 CFR 261.52(a).
2. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building or the areas listed in Exhibits A-C and Big Meadows Area, shown on Exhibit D. 36 CFR 261.52(d).
3. Operating an internal combustion engine, except on a designated National Forest System road, trail, or in areas listed in Exhibits A-C and Big Meadows Area, shown on Exhibit D. 36 CFR 261.52(h).
4. Welding, or operating an acetylene or other torch with an open flame. 36 CFR 261.52(i).
5. Using an explosive. 36 CFR 261.52(b).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission. Persons with a valid California Campfire Permit are not exempt from the prohibitions listed above. However, persons with a valid California Campfire Permit may use portable stoves and lanterns with shut-off valves, using gas, jellied petroleum or pressurized liquid fuel.
3. Persons with a valid Forest Products Removal Permit for fuelwood are exempt from Prohibition No. 3 when gathering fuelwood as specified on the permit.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.



