







GRAND MESA NATIONAL FOREST - GRAND VALLEY RANGER DISTRICT

All areas within the Grand Mesa National Forest are available for firewood cutting as described in the 2014 fuelwood packet PROVIDED NO RESOURCE DAMAGE IS OCCURRING, unless otherwise noted.
Use the Grand Mesa National Forest map for locations of all open roads.

Not All CLOSED areas are shown on this map. DO NOT CUT firewood in areas with "NO FIREWOOD CUTTING" signs posted. Hwy 65 is open for DEAD DOWN fuelwood ONLY. DO NOT CUT standing trees within 100 feet of the existing road. Please use established pull-outs.

DO NOT CUT trees marked with paint, plastic ribbon and/or signs.






All areas CLOSED to fuelwood cutting are shown on this map.
