### **U.S. Forest Service to Co-Host International Migratory Bird Day Event**

**(STEAMBOAT SPRINGS, Colo.) May 8, 2014** – In celebration of International Migratory Bird Day, the Routt National Forest will be co-hosting a family-friendly event on Saturday, May 10 near Hayden, Colo.

The Hahns Peak/Bears Ears Ranger District has partnered with the Nature Conservancy, Yampatika and the Yampa Valley Birding Club to put on the free family activity.

The event will be held at the Nature Conservancy's Carpenter Ranch, located just east of Hayden, from 8 a.m.-12 p.m. It will feature a bird walk, arts, crafts, an appearance by Woodsy Owl, story time, songs, and a build-a-nest activity.
