



ORDER 18-2014-10-02

EMERGENCY CLOSURE FOR PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY

**WILLAMETTE NATIONAL FOREST
Middle Fork Ranger District**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited on the roads described in this order within the Willamette National Forest. This order will become effective upon signature, and will remain in effect until rescinded.

- (1) Being on a road closed for public health and safety.**
§36 CFR 261.54(e)

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR §261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Any person with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.**
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local official or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.**

DESCRIPTION OF AREA:

- Road 1912-653. This is a dead end spur road.
- Road 1835 between the junctions of 1835-240 and 1835-365.








Exhibit A: Map for Forest Order 18-2014-10-02
