- The area south of Road 58 (5870, 5890 and 4280 roads) is open to wood cutting within 100 feet of the road (unless otherwise signed) without a special request. Ensure that you are not within 300 feet of lake, river, or stream when wood cutting.
- The clearing on the 2631 road will periodically have wood placed there from ODOT’s HWY 26 project. Firewood cutting is allowed here unless otherwise signed closed to entry. Entrance, egress, and turn around space is limited, trailers are not allowed here.
- Due to many roadside locations directly adjacent to sensitive riparian habitat, please use the Special Request Process for firewood collection on the Zigzag Ranger District. Firewood cutting is prohibited along the 2612, 2618, and in the Old Maid Flats area.

The last day to cut firewood for the 2016 season is November 30th, 2016. Your 2016 permit and tags will no longer be valid after Nov. 30th. Firewood permits will be available again in the late spring or early summer of 2017, for the 2017 season.
