

ORDER
FOREST DEVELOPMENT TRAILS
USDA - FOREST SERVICE
GIFFORD PINCHOT NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited upon all Forest Development Trails located within and/or administered by the GIFFORD PINCHOT NATIONAL FOREST, until rescinded:

- (1) Being on a trail in violation of posted instructions. 36 CFR 261.55 (a)
- (2) Using any type of vehicle in violation of posted instructions. 36 CFR 261.55 (b)
- (3) Use by any type of traffic or mode of transportation in violation of posted instructions. 36 CFR 261.55 (c)
- (4) Operating a vehicle in violation of the posted instructions for the width, weight, length or any other limitations in the posted instructions. 36 CFR 261.55 (d)
- (5) Shortcutting a switchback in a trail in violation of posted instructions. 36 CFR 261.55 (e)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following are exempt from this order:

- 1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
- 2. Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
