Celebrate 50 Years with a Wilderness Passport

JOHN DAY, OR – The Forest Service is celebrating the 50th anniversary of the Wilderness Act during 2014.

As part of the anniversary celebration, the National Forests of Eastern Oregon, the Wallowa-Whitman, Umatilla and the Malheur National Forests have introduced an Eastern Oregon Wilderness Passport project for our wilderness enthusiasts. The Eastern Oregon Wilderness Passport has a page

for each of the seven wildernesses in Eastern Oregon (Hells Canyon, Eagle Cap, Wenaha-Tucannon, North Fork of the Umatilla, North Fork of the John Day, Strawberry Mountain and Monument Rock).

Passports can be picked up at any of the Wallowa-Whitman, Umatilla or Malheur district or supervisor's offices. After visiting one of your Wildernesses stop by a district or supervisor's office and have the Wilderness passport page stamped with the unique stamp for that particular Wilderness.
