**Temporary Road Closure
Bull Trout Lake Road**

PROHIBITIONS: Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a), the following act is prohibited on the area, roads, and trails as described in this order, all within the Middle Fork Ranger District, Salmon-Challis National Forest **beginning approximately April 15th through approximately June 5th annually.**

1. Using a motorized vehicle on the road described below that is posted as closed. **36 CFR 261.54(a)**

EXEMPTIONS: Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

National Forest System Road # 40100, **Bull Trout Lake Road**, beginning at the junction with the State Highway 21, Township 12 North, Range 10 East, Section 24, ending 1.7 miles at Bull Trout lake Campground, and including the Campground road system, Township 11 North, Range 10 East, Sections 9 and 10.

The above-described area is within the proclaimed and administrative boundary of Middle Fork Ranger District, Salmon-Challis National Forest, in Custer County, Idaho.

PURPOSE:

This closure is necessary to prevent excessive road damage and unnecessary repair costs to drainage structures caused by motorized vehicle use when the **Bull Trout Lake Road** is wet and soft during spring snow melt.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for a individual or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571 (b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
3. This Order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order in the above-described area.
